The college places great emphasis on the continuous maintenance and upgradation of its IT facilities to support both educational and administrative functions.

2. Wi-Fi and LAN Facilities

The campus is well-equipped with Wi-Fi and LAN facilities, ensuring comprehensive internet coverage. In 2019, a dedicated server system was installed for campus network management by Bharat Sanchar Nigam Limited (BSNL), providing a robust bandwidth of 50 MBPS. This setup includes a local internet hub established by BSNL, connecting all internet services within the college. Wired and wireless internet access points are available in all campus buildings, allowing students and staff to utilize a wide range of online resources and services.

3. Website and Online Interfaces

The college's IT infrastructure includes a dynamic online presence through its website, gcbahu.ac, acquired in 2020. This platform serves as a transparent, efficient, and effective interface for all stakeholders. The media in-charge regularly updates the website to ensure it reflects the latest information and activities. Additionally, the college has an official Facebook page to showcase student talents and events.

4. Computer Facilities

The college is equipped with a sufficient number of computers for both administrative tasks and student use, all connected to the internet. Maintenance tasks, including software installations, antivirus updates, and the upkeep of electronic gadgets, are managed by designated in-charges.
