# **Alumni Feedback Analysis**






become social and built lifelong relationships only because of the college. They admit that the college provided those wings so that they can fly high to pursue their goals. They give credit to the college for their present position in life.





- 6--- More books on newer topics in the library




- The college has taken steps to enhance participation of alumni in college activities and events.

- College library is updated by purchasing new books.


# **Students' Feedback Analysis**




#### PARENT FEEDBACK ANALYSIS


Though all parents are asked to give feedback but—the college has received only forty feedbacks. The 57% parents rated the quality of academics as highly satisfied 43% parents felt it satisfied. It means all the parents are satisfied. The 65% parents are highly satisfied with the infrastructure and other facilities and 35% are satisfied with the facilities provided by the college. The co-curricular activities are also rated by the parents. Among them 40% are highly satisfied and 53% are satisfied and 7% opted others. The quality of academic resources is rated by 20% of the parents as highly satisfied, by 70% as satisfied and 10% opted others. ## **Suggestions of Parents:-**


- 1. There should be zero vehicles parking fee for students.

- 5. Parents suggested that campus should have WI-FI connectivity





- The campus has started WI-FI connectivity


#### TEACHERS' FEEDBACK ANALYSIS


Most of the teachers (56%) are strongly agree with the relevance of syllabus as per need of the society, framed by the university and 44% are agree with it. (RS1). 62% are strongly agreed with the logical order of the contents of syllabus with contemporary topics and 38% are agreeing with it. (RS2) The 75% teachers are strongly agreed with the correlation between syllabus and course and 25% teachers are agreeing with it. (RS3) The 75% teachers are strongly agreed with the effectiveness of syllabus and availability of books for semester pattern and 25% are agreeing with it. (RS4) The evaluation methods for assessment of syllabus and employability was received ratings as strongly agree by 81 % and as agree by 19%. (RS5) The Syllabus imparts skill, knowledge and Social awareness as per real life situations was rated 62% as strongly agreed and, 38% as agreed, (RS6) The 69% teachers are strongly agreed that the crosscutting issues like gender equality, professional ethics, human values and environment are covered by syllabus and 31% are agree with it. (RS7). The 62% teachers are strongly agreed with the fact that the constitutional values, duties, rights etc. are covered by the present syllabus and 38% are agreed with it. (RS8). The 25% of the teachers are strongly agreed, 62% are only agreed and 13% are neutral on the fact that the current syllabus tries to build the opportunities in terms of employability.























# Suggestions by the teachers:-
