## Report on NSS 7 days Special Camp **Session 2020-2021**

As per the permission received through letter no. NSS/ 21/41 dated 28.01.2021 of Maharshi Dayanand University, Rohtak, a 7 days special camp was organized by the NSS Unit of Govt. College Bahu, Jhajjar from 04 February 2021 to 10 February 2021 at Bahu Village. In this camp 51 volunteers (Girls) participated. The details of the day by day activities performed in the camp are as under:-

On 4<sup>th</sup> February 2021 (Day 1) – On 04 Feb.2021 the 7 day NSS Camp was started at Bahu Village. It was the opening day of the camp. For the opening ceremony Dr. Sunil Kumar, Administrative In charge of the college was invited. He shared his life experience and motivated the NSS volunteers by his valuable thoughts about social responsibility of youth towards the society. Then after, the premises of the college was cleaned by the NSS Volunteers.

**On 5<sup>th</sup> February 2021 (Day 2)** - To spread the awareness among the village on the road safety, a rally on the traffic rules was organized. Through this rally, the NSS volunteers interacted with the villagers and tried to educate them on the various rules and regulations of the driving in order to keep themselves safe on the road. The volunteers were told rules about safe driving, traffic signals, importance of zebra crossing etc. Then after, an extension lecture on 'Cashless Transaction' and 'Digital India' was delivered by Dr. Mohan Kumar, Assistant Professor (Department of Commerce). In the lecture he expressed different methods like debit card, credit card, RTGS, NEFT, Internet Banking etc. of Cashless Transaction and Zero Budget. He also motivated the NSS Volunteers to encourage other methods of transaction like Google, pay, pay tm etc.

On 6<sup>th</sup> February 2021 (Day 3) – On day third (06.02.2021) a cleanliness programme was organized in village Bahu. Most of the community made temples and other buildings were cleaned up by the NSS Volunteers. After it, First Aid and Home Nursing Training was given by Sh. Vinay Kumar of District Red Cross Society, Jhajjar. The participants created very beautiful ideas through their menhandi designs. In these competitions,

On 7<sup>th</sup> February 2021 (Day 4) – On 4<sup>th</sup> day of the camp, a lecture on the topic "No Use of Plastic" was delivered by Dr. Sunil Kumar, Assistant Professor, G.C. Bahu. Four competitions -Mehandi Competition, Chart Making Competition, Slogan Writing Competition, Essay Writing Competition were held on same day.

On 8<sup>th</sup> February 2021 (Day 5) – On 5<sup>th</sup> Day– An extension lecture was delivered by Dr. Anita Phogat, Associate Professor (Department of Political Science ) to the NSS Volunteers. She gave all the details about the NSS like when it was established, what was its aim or motto. She encouraged the volunteers by saying that the devotion of NSS volunteers to the Camp was remarkable.

On 9<sup>th</sup> February 2021 (Day 6) – On that day of the NSS Camp a cleanliness Rally was organized to spread awareness regarding cleanliness. Moreover, a lecture was delivered by Meena (Health Worker, PHC, Bahu) on the topic "Health and hygiene". An extension lecture on the topic "Role of Youth to Achieve the Goal Swatch Bharat Mission" was also delivered by Dr. Anil Kumar, Assistant Professor, GC Sampla.

On 10<sup>th</sup> February 2021 (Day 7) – The 7<sup>th</sup> and last day of the camp was devoted to closing ceremony. Sh. Raj Kumar Verma, Principal of the college was invited as chief guest. He addressed the volunteers and motivated them to achieve lofty aims in life. On the same day, there were many activities performed by the NSS volunteers like poem, recitation, patriotic songs on the topic "Women Empowerment, Beti Bachao Beti Padhao". They showed the present scenario of women in the society.
