Academic and Administrative Audit Report of Govt. College, Bahu, Jhajjar

Introduction:

This report presents the findings of the Academic and Administrative Audit conducted at Government College, Bahu, Jhajjar. The College offers B.A. and B.Com programs with a total intake of 420 students and a faculty strength of 16 members (10 regular and 6 extension lecturers). The audit highlights significant strengths, including well-maintained infrastructure, a comprehensive library, accessibility facilities, and robust mentor-mentee and alumni records. The college is equipped with modern amenities like computer and English language labs and smart classrooms. It benefits from strong community and alumni support, active student participation in extracurricular activities, and effective use of ICT tools. However, areas for improvement include the need for permanent affiliation, NAAC accreditation, enhanced transportation facilities, and increased non-teaching staff. The report also includes recommendations for future development, emphasizing academic and administrative enhancements, and outlines plans for expanding the college's program offerings.

Strengths of College:

- The College has sufficient infrastructure to run the programs. It has a spacious library with a seating capacity of 60 students and a good collection of books.
- 2. The College has ramp and toilet facilities for physically challenged individuals.
- 3. The mentor-mentee record is well maintained.
- 4. The alumni records are well organized.
- 5. The staff members are well qualified and committed.
- 6. The computer lab has 20 computers.
- 7. The English Language Lab is equipped with 20 computers.
- The library is well-stocked with books and subscribed journals & magazines along with 952 books of placement cell.
- 9. The College building has 17 classrooms and 04 furnished labs.
- 10. The College has 10 acres of land for the development of sports and other facilities.
- 11. There is a 10 KW Solar Panel installed.
- 12. The College has a separate E-Library section.
- 13. There is a separate Book Bank section in the library.
- 14. The College provides 50 MBPS internet speed.
- 15. CCTV cameras are installed for security at main entry, college entry and Library entry.
- 16. The College has subscribed to N-List Inflibnet.
- 17. The College coordinates online/distance learning/outreach programs of IIRS, ISRO, Dehradun.
- 18. The campus is lush green and well-maintained.
- 19. The placement cell has 952 books.
- 20. The College has well-equipped sports facilities.

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- 21. The College has a robust feedback system for continuous improvement through IQAC.
- 22. Active involvement of students in various extracurricular activities and clubs.
- 23. Strong support from the local community and alumni network.
- 24. Effective use of ICT tools in teaching and administration.
- 25. Well maintained Smart Class Rooms

Areas of Gaps:

- Lack of permanent affiliation.
- 2. NAAC accreditation is required. Although college has submitted IIQA for this.
- 3. Lack of transportation facilities for students.
- 4. Insufficient non-teaching staff.
- 5. Inadequate documentation of college activities.
- 6. The formation of an R & D cell is required.
- 7. The multipurpose hall is unfurnished.
- 8. Fire safety measures do not meet the norms.

Recommendations:

- 1. Ensure regular maintenance of the generator.
- 2. Appoint a Physical Education teacher.
- Increase the number of non-teaching staff.
- 4. Furnish the multipurpose hall with sufficient furniture and accessories.
- 5. Establish language labs for Hindi with adequate seating capacity.
- 6. Develop a comprehensive transportation plan for students.
- 7. Enhance documentation practices for various co-currcular activities.
- 8. Form an R & D cell to encourage research and innovation.
- Allocate funds for regular maintenance and development.
- 10. Strengthen community engagement and partnerships for collaborative projects.
- 11. Encourage faculty development programs to enhance teaching and administrative skills.
- 12. Fire safety measures to be implimented

- 1. Introduction of New Subjects and Programs
 - Planning to introduce Mathematics as a subject.
 - Initiating B.Sc. Non-Medical program.
 - Starting postgraduate courses in History and Political Science.
- 2. Research and Development

 - Encouraging faculty to engage in research projects and publications.
- 3. Community Engagement and Outreach
